can they dedicate to building (per day/week), if they have the necessary skills and what the total cost to build/insure will be.

Dave also suggested enrolling in EAA SportAir Workshops to improve your homebuilding skills in working with sheet metal, wood, welding, fiber glass, fabric, etc. or take advantage of the knowledge and skills of fellow chapter members and to consult with an EAA Flight Advisor prior to first flight.
